Every employee has rights, benefits, and responsibilities flowing from the Collective Agreement between MacEwan University and MSA as well as Government legislation.

Membership in MSA will enable you to voting privileges. MSA is a democratic organization. Major issues are decided by a vote of all members at general meetings or by ballots.

Two part-time staff members under the direction of an elected executive manage the day-to-day functions of the MSA. A Labor Relations Officer, as well as the MSA President are available to meet with members and discuss their concerns. Any member can run for executive positions and there are various sub-committees in which you can become involved.

We hold AGM's during the spring and fall where you can express concerns, obtain information, vote, and socialize with other members.

MSA has established corporate discount rates with various businesses throughout the Edmonton. Presentation of your Association Card will allow you to access this benefit. A list can be obtained from the MSA Office or website.
