



# NOTICE TO EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEES

On June 28, 2024, the Board received a successorship application from the MacEwan Staff Union affecting the MacEwan Staff Association and The Board of Governors of Grant McEwan University.

The application asks the Board to declare that the MacEwan Staff Union is the successor trade union to the MacEwan Staff Association as a result of a name change. The application affects the following Board certificate:

The Board has accepted the application under sections 12(4) and 49 of the *Labour Relations Code*.

If there are no objections to the application, this matter will be brought before the Chair or a Vice Chair sitting alone for disposition, with the recommendation that Certificate No. C2187-2023 be revoked and replaced by a new certificate to be issued to the parties naming MacEwan Staff Union as the Union and The Board of Governors of Grant McEwan University as the Employer for a unit of employees described as: "*All non-academic employees.*"

Any employees or groups of employees affected by this application may make representations on this matter by filing a written statement with the Alberta Labour Relations Board on or before **August 26, 2024**. Please note that any document sent to the Board regarding the application will be placed on the public record and provided to the parties affected by the application.

The statement must give in detail the reasons for the representation. If an individual on behalf of a group of employees files the statement, it must contain the names, addresses, telephone numbers and signatures of all employees supporting the statement. In addition, it must contain the name, address, telephone number and signature of the individual representing employees who have signed the statement. If you desire, you have the right to retain an agent or lawyer to represent your interests.
